演講主題：China's Gray Zone Strategy of Layered Coercion in the South China Sea: Challenges and Countermeasures.



Andrew S. Erickson 教授
(美國海軍戰爭學院中國海事研究所)

Andrew S. Erickson (艾立信) 博士是美國海軍戰爭學院 (Naval War College, NWC) 中國海事研究所 (China Maritime Studies Institute, CMSI) 的戰略學教授 (具終身教職)。他是 CMSI 的創始核心成員之一，協助該所於2006年正式成立，並在其發展過程中扮演了關鍵角色；於2021至2023年間擔任研究主任。CMSI 的成立啟發了其他研究機構的成立，其中包括國防部其他軍種的中國研究中心，Erickson 博士也為這些機構提供諮詢與支持。他同時是中國航空航太研究所 (China Aerospace Studies Institute, CASI) 的研究員。

Erickson 博士現任哈佛大學費正清中國研究中心 (John King Fairbank Center for Chinese Studies) 的訪問學者，自2008年起即為該中心的研究員 (Associate in Research)。此外，他也是外交關係協會 (Council on Foreign Relations)、海事政策與戰略研究所 (Institute of Maritime Policy & Strategy) 國際諮詢委員會成員，以及南新英格蘭美日協會 (Japan-America Society of Southern New England) 和美日海軍友好協會紐波特分會 (JANAF New Bedford) 董事會成員。他擔任《海軍戰爭學院評論》(Naval War College Review) 與《亞洲政策》(Asia Policy) 期刊的編輯委員，同時為《19FortyFive》網站的特約編輯。他

曾於海軍戰爭學院與韓國延世大學授課，也協助海軍戰爭學院為將官級軍官提供量身訂製的教育，包括校園內及在檀香山、臺北、高雄與拿坡里等校園外地點之課程。

Erickson 博士積極參與多層次對話（1軌、1.5軌與2軌對話），例如作為代表出席香格里拉對話（Shangri-La Dialogue）。他曾獲頒「海軍傑出文職服務勳章」（Navy Superior Civilian Service Medal）、海軍戰爭學院首屆「文職教師研究卓越獎」，以及「國家亞洲研究局」（National Bureau of Asian Research, NBR）首屆「喬伊夫獎」（Ellis Joffe Prize for PLA Studies）。他最新合編的書籍《中國兩棲作戰：對兩岸攻擊的前景分析》（*Chinese Amphibious Warfare: Prospects for a Cross-Strait Invasion*）獲選為2025年 Samuel B. Griffith 基金會年度出版物，並入選為美國海軍陸戰隊司令專業閱讀計畫2025年閱讀書單

Dr. Andrew S. Erickson is Professor of Strategy (tenured full professor) in the U.S. Naval War College (NWC)'s China Maritime Studies Institute (CMSI). A core founding member, he helped establish CMSI and stand it up officially in 2006, and has played an integral role in its development; from 2021–23 he served as Research Director. CMSI inspired the creation of other analytical organizations, which Erickson has advised and supported, including China centers for all other Department of Defense military services; he is a China Aerospace Studies Institute Associate. Erickson is currently a Visiting Scholar at Harvard University's John King Fairbank Center for Chinese Studies, where he has been an Associate in Research since 2008. He is also a member of the Council on Foreign Relations, the Institute of Maritime Policy & Strategy's International Advisory Committee, and the Japan-America Society of Southern New England and Japan-America Navy Friendship Association (JANAFNA)-Newport's Board of Directors. He serves on the editorial boards of Naval War College Review and Asia Policy and is a Contributing Editor at 19FortyFive. Erickson has taught courses at NWC and Yonsei University. He provides flag officer tailored education for NWC, both on and off campus; including in Honolulu, Taipei, Kaohsiung, and Naples. He participates in a range of Track 1, 1.5, and 2 discussions, including as a delegate at the Shangri-La Dialogue. Erickson has received the Navy Superior Civilian Service Medal, NWC's inaugural Civilian Faculty Research Excellence Award, and the National Bureau of Asian Research's inaugural Ellis Joffe Prize for PLA Studies. Erickson's latest coedited volume—Chinese Amphibious Warfare: Prospects for a Cross-Strait Invasion—has been named the Samuel B. Griffith Foundation's 2025 Publication of the Year and selected for the
